While we are making plans to celebrate the season with our loved ones, please remember the veterans in need. The VA has a list of items they are requesting for veterans. The complete list can be found by doing an internet search for "Wisconsin VA hospital wish list 2024". We will also have printed lists available, with sizes, at the post for you to take on your next shopping trip along with barrels to hold your donations. You don't have to buy a lot to make an impact, even one item will help, and there are items to fit all budgets.

Men: New T-shirts, sweatshirts (hoodies), athletic shorts and shoes, winter coats.

Women: New sweatpants/yoga pants, sweatshirts, t-shirts, athletic shoes, winter coats.

For men and women: Toiletry items like Dove soap, bodywash, deodorant, lip balm, razors (minimum 3 blades), baby wipes. Food items like 4 or 8 oz bottles of juice and water, granola, chips, individually wrapped packages of gum and mints, goldfish crackers, cookies, fruit strips, peanut butter or cheese crackers, shelf stable coffee creamer, sugar packets or sugar substitute. Backpacks, playing cards, board games, puzzle books, large print crossword, Sudoku, word find puzzles and fidget spinners. All subscription reading glasses, planners, pocket calendars, small memo books or notebooks. Gift cards for fuel and food to help veterans afford to go to their appointments. As you can see, the needs are varied and don't have to be expensive.

We will wrap presents for the children of the community followed by a pizza party and white elephant card game. Lisa Brickl has offered to bartend for us too! December 16th marks the 80th Anniversary of the Ardennes Offensive, better known as the Battle of the Bulge in World War II. German forces launched a surprise attack on Allied forces in the forested Ardennes region in Belgium, Luxembourg, and France. It was brutal battle both in terms of combat and elements. Harsh winter conditions made it hard for the tired and battered Allies to regroup and go on the counter. After gaining a foothold, the Allies launched a counter offensive and were able to push the Nazis and the war into Germany. When it was all said and done the US suffered 83,000 casualties, lost 800 tanks and over 1,000 aircrafts. Please take a moment to reflect on and honor the sacrifice our Father's and Grandfather's made during the Battle of the Bulge in December 1944.

On January 11th the SAL will be hosting a Spaghetti Dinner at the Legion in honor of local serviceman Quintin Browne. All proceeds will go to the Quintin Browne Memorial Scholarship. Prep for the dinner will be January 10th.
